Superhero Number Day – Friday 5th December

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to share that on **Friday 5th December**, children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will be taking part in our very own **Superhero Number Day!** The day is designed to celebrate early number skills and to build confidence, curiosity and enjoyment in maths through playful, hands-on learning.

To help bring the day to life, children are invited to come to school dressed as a Number Superhero! Outfits can be simple, creative, and homemade—there is absolutely no expectation to buy anything new.

- A T-shirt with your child's favourite number stuck or drawn onto it
- A homemade number badge or belt made from card or felt
- A simple cape made from a pillowcase, scarf, or piece of fabric — please ensure capes are safely secured with Velcro or soft ties, avoiding anything that could tighten around the neck, as capes can pose a choking hazard
- Wristbands decorated with number symbols, shapes or patterns
- Brightly coloured T-shirts and leggings in superhero style
- Homemade masks (optional) made from card or felt



These ideas are simply suggestions—children are welcome to wear any superhero-themed outfit they choose.

For safety reasons, please ensure children do not wear false nails or earrings and that they come in sensible footwear. Long hair should be tied up as usual.

Throughout the day, children will take part in engaging number-based activities such as problem-solving missions, counting challenges and superhero-style maths adventures designed to spark imagination and strengthen early number understanding.

We are looking forward to a fun-filled, number-powered day of learning!
